Welcome to Camping les Falaises de Toussaint.

The campsite is committed to an environmental charter, guaranteeing its guests a holiday destination surrounded by unspoilt nature. Respect for and protection of the environment are among our top priorities in managing this establishment. In order to honour this commitment, we have implemented a number of measures to preserve the natural environment of the campsite and the well-being of all those who stay or work here. It is therefore essential for us to minimise the impact that our activities may have on the environment.

In order to respect this commitment, we have implemented a number of measures that comply with the strict performance and environmental quality requirements of various environmental labels.

The environment doesn't take holidays!

We invite you to consult this charter, which outlines our various environmental actions and how you can participate in our efforts during your stay or assignment with us.

Our commitments :

Promoting and introducing our guests to local products : by promoting the sale of local and regional products in our convenience store.

- Managing and optimising our water consumption : by regularly reading water metres, installing individual water metres, installing push buttons on 100% of our taps on the campsite, and naturally encouraging our guests to report any leaks they notice and to avoid waste by limiting watering to the most thirsty varieties and to the coolest hours of the day.
- Installation of rainwater collectors.
- Aerators on all taps and shower heads in order to minimise water consumption.

- Respecting biodiversity : by favouring regional species, we avoid chemicals and other pesticides, and we do not mow the lawn too short in order to preserve miniature flora and fauna.
- Saving energy : throughout the campsite, all lighting has been replaced with energy-saving bulbs.
- Solar-powered outdoor lighting on the campsite. Lighting in the two toilet blocks is 100% LED with motion detectors.
- The cleaning products used are environmentally friendly (eco-label certified) or made with mild chemicals. We do not use wipes. We make maximum use of modern materials for wiping surfaces and windows to minimise the use of cleaning products or paper towels.
- Most of our documents are digitised to encourage electronic correspondence (contracts, price lists and brochures are sent by e-mail whenever possible).

Help us protect the environment by following these simple actions :

- Place recyclable waste in the yellow-lidded bins at the campsite entrance, without putting it in bags. Do not throw cigarette butts, paper or other rubbish on the ground. Place batteries at reception and everything else in the green bins at the campsite entrance. There is a glass recycling container 50 metres from the campsite exit, or you can place your glass in the wooden crate at the campsite entrance next to the other bins.
- We have bus timetables and walking and cycling routes available at reception.
